#### **GRADING SYSTEM**

Our classification scale ranges from 0 to 20, in which 10 is the minimum mark to obtain approval. The awarding of ECTS classification is based on the distribution of marks obtained by all the students approved in the course unit in the last three academic years (can be extended to the last four or five years, if necessary), according to the following distribution:

ECTS credit unit is a Unit of measure of student work corresponding to the European System of Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System). One academic year of full-time work corresponds to 60 ECTS credits, considering for such the total number of annual working hours of 1680. One ECTS credit corresponds to 28 hours of work (includes classroom activities, assessments and autonomous work

#### **TUITON FEES AND SCHOOL INSURANCE**

The tuiton fee is waived for exchange students.

The **school insurance is a mandatory fee (2,10€)** which must be paid upon arrival at FFUL.

#### **ACCOMODATION**


